Patrick Matthews and Lynn Kidman briefed the Committee on the Environmental Management Soils Sub-Project in general with emphasis on current investigations, Corrective Action Units (CAU) 371 and 372. Topics covered include:

- Surface soils contamination at the Nevada Test Site
- Soils Sub-Project responsibility
- Corrective Action Sites (CAS) and CAUs
- Use of flyover radiological surveys and sampling from previous studies
- Corrective Action Alternative (CAA), evaluation, standards and remedy selection decision factors
- CAU 371, Johnnie Boy Unit Crater history and status
- CAU 372, Palanquin/Cabriolet Unit Craters history and status

The Committee requested additional information including:

- Final investigation results for CAU 371 including a larger map of the flyover areas
- Cost estimates for the various closure scenarios as well as examples of prior Soils CAU closure costs (planning or budget estimates will be sufficient)
- Worker exposure and any inhalation dose data from previous projects

The next meeting will be scheduled when final investigation results for CAU 371 are provided. Results are expected in mid-October with a meeting to be scheduled within the following two weeks.
